At the core remains the value of the cinematic figure of the fallen guardian for contemporary understandings of urban space and urban crime control and how films are clear examples of the ways in which the ideology of repression is reproduced. Explored are the crime control measures of private policing in relation to *RoboCop* (1987), preventative policing and *Minority Report* (2002), mass incarceration in *The Dark Knight Rises* (2012), and extra-judicial killing in *Blade Runner 2049* (2017). criminology, cultural criminology, urban studies, and beyond.
