Even if French is remotely related to the English language, it is more generally compared to other Romance languages such as Spanish and Italian. Currently, there are around thirty countries who name French as one of their official languages. In Canada, French is commonly used in the Quebec region only. On top of that, the French language was actually used as the official language for international diplomacy until the initial years of the twentieth century when the English language took over.
