PSALM 119:105 – THE LAW AS A LAMP

RIGHTEOUSLY THROUGH THE SPIRIT. THIS TRANSITION IS CRUCIAL FOR INTERPRETING BIBLE VERSES ABOUT THE LAW IN A CHRISTIAN CONTEXT.

- ROMANS 6:14 – “FOR SIN SHALL NO LONGER BE YOUR MASTER, BECAUSE YOU ARE NOT UNDER THE LAW, BUT UNDER GRACE.”
- JOHN 1:17 – “FOR THE LAW WAS GIVEN THROUGH MOSES; GRACE AND TRUTH CAME THROUGH JESUS CHRIST.”
- HEBREWS 8:6 – “BUT NOW JESUS HAS OBTAINED A MORE EXCELLENT MINISTRY, INASMUCH AS HE IS ALSO THE MEDIATOR OF A BETTER COVENANT.”

HOW THE LAW REVEALS SIN
