Here, then, was Hungary-Suez in its totality. More should be known about the crisis for these reasons alone. It also recalls a time when Americas conduct as the worlds primary superpower was as clear and visionary as it was purposeful and constructive, in a word, when American diplomacy was at its zenith.
