Through the political connections of founder Sen. Elmer Thomas, the resort enjoyed a great deal of early success. From its founding through the 1930s, it became a getaway to relax, chum-around, gamble, and even partake in some illegal bootleg whisky. Medicine Park became known as the jewel of the Southwest.
